Our Ask of the EGM Resolution 1 Audit

Considerations:

- HCF has the right to dispense with the obligation, to appoint an auditor formally to audit HCF's latest annual accounts.
- If HCF decides to dispense with this obligation in relation to the latest annual accounts, it is then able to decide (in an AGM), not to appoint an auditor in relation to those accounts.
- In each of HCF's previous year the board has recommended that the obligation be dispensed with and HCF has then gone on to decide in AGM not to appoint an auditor
- The board is recommending the same this year

Our Ask of the EGM Resolutions 2 & 3 –Giving Notice of General Meetings

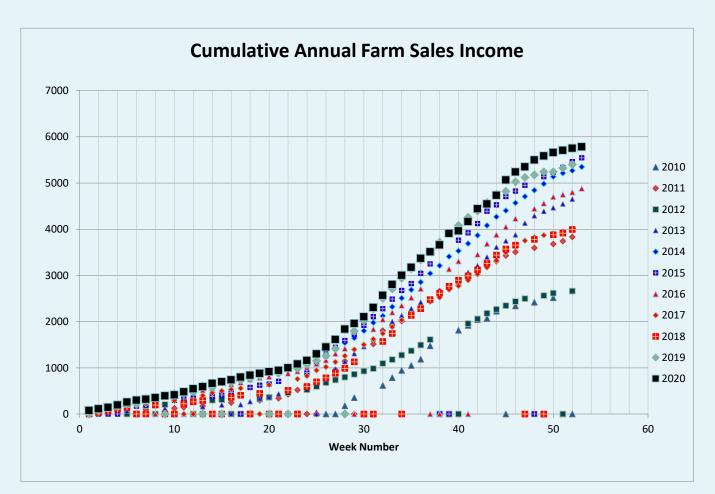


2021 Best year for produce sales

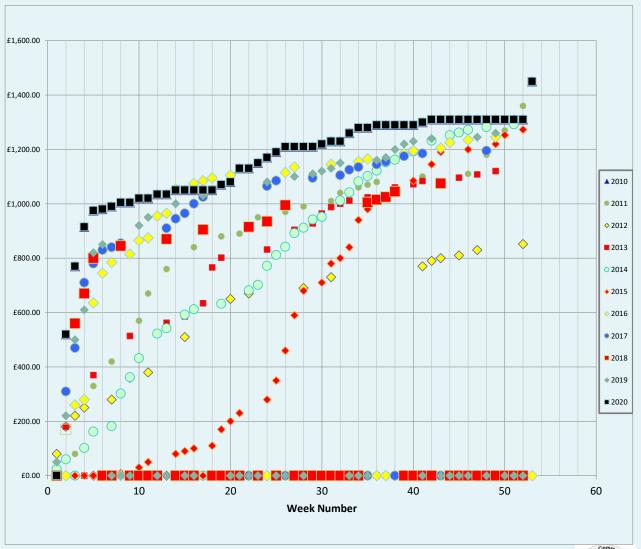






Highest Stakeholder fees

- 14 people pre-paid for 2021 in December 2020

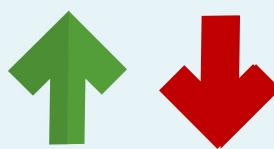




Income and Expenditure
